

### Picking up students early

Over the past week there have been many incidences of students being picked up early as parents do not like crowd at the school gate. Due to the locked gates and the number of parents around, students will not be allowed out of the gates between 2:45pm – 3:00pm. Of course, if there is an emergency please call the office otherwise you will be asked to wait until 3pm pick up time.

Last term we did trial a staggered home time, however, due to the large number of siblings / cousins in the school we found that parents had to wait around the gates for a longer period of time.

### Term 3 – Changes to school operations

**Scripture** - Scripture classes resumed last Wednesday for all students in Years 1-4.

**Student teachers** are now permitted to complete their practicums within schools.

External sporting companies - We are very fortunate to have received a grant of \$3200 which will enable students in Years 2 – 4 to participate in a gymnastics program commencing on Thursday next week. This involves a 40 minute lesson each week for 6 weeks. 'Fit School Fit Kids' have stringent COVID-19 plans in place to ensure staff and student safety and appropriate social distancing. This includes taking the temperature of every child before they participate. If you have any concerns with this and your child is in Years 2, 3 or 4 please contact the school.

Students are now allowed to assemble together in larger groups of up to 15 minutes in duration. Whilst this time frame doesn't allow us to recommence our weekly assemblies, we will be holding brief meetings and presentations once a week. Our school assemblies are continuing to be held using the platform 'zoom'.

### Winter PSSA

Winter PSSA in the Auburn Zone is going ahead. However, I have made the difficult decision that our school will not be participating. Given the outbreak of hotspots in the area I had serious concerns about the health and safety of our students and staff. It was a difficult decision, however, in the end health always comes first and I take great responsibility in ensuring any activities we do are not putting our students at a greater risk. A note will be going home to all parents who recently paid \$25 for Term 3 PSSA.

With regards to carnivals, all regional and national carnivals have been cancelled for 2020. We are hoping to hold a 'fun' athletics carnival on site during Semester 2.

### **External visitors**

All visitors to the school are required by the Department of Education (DoE) to sign an agreement to abide by strict the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) guidelines and NSW Health advice on COVID – 19 practices.

At this stage the Department of Education are still not permitting parents to visit schools except for special circumstances.

# School drop off and pick up routines

Our current routine will remain the same with parents dropping students at the school gates in the morning and collecting their children at the end of the day from the school gates. We understand that this is not ideal, however, we have put this in place to minimise any community transmission of COVID 19.

Due to COVID-19, our Annual General Meeting (AGM) has been postponed a number of times. Under the current restrictions we are still unable to meet in person, but the Education Minister has now approved for these meetings to be held online. # Hygiene practices and enhanced cleaning
