Year 3 & 5 Check in Assessment

The Department of Education has made available to schools a new online literacy and numeracy assessment package for Year 3 and 5 students. With the absence of NAPLAN in 2020, data from these assessments will be of benefit in identifying what students can do, measured against state-wide learning outcomes, and will inform further teaching and learning.

The Year 5 assessments will take place between 17 August and September 4, while the Year 3 assessments will take place between 21 September and 23 October.

The check-in assessments are designed to supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy, and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.
